May I also request you to remember all the brothers who had rested in the Lord in this month in your daily prayers.






Mariadas, the Procurator. Br. Sunil the Director of the Candidates along with Br. Prakash made the gathering a memorable one.

🕨 H i n d u p u r



Heavenly Father, we thank you for the year that has passed and the many blessings you have showered upon us. We beg your pardon in our many failings




