

As Paul states that as for us to die is to live in Christ. What does then Death mean? Does it mean to stop breathing? Does it mean that we stop functioning physically? Death means to become renewed in Christ. Death means to give up the entire old self and become new like Christ.

Besides, there are two kinds of discipleship as Bonhoeffer, a protestant theologian states — cheap discipleship and costly discipleship. Can we pay for grace and get it owned? No. Because, Jesus has already paid heavily on the cross which cost can never be compared to anything upon the face of earth. Cheap grace can be paid and owned but costly grace can never be acquired by any sort. Costly grace is bestowed upon us by Jesus alone. Costly grace is what Jesus asks the rich man, "go and sell all that you have." Costly grace is where Jesus tells in the judgment day. "Come, you who are chosen." Costly grace is what Jesus tells a thief, "This very night, you will be in paradise." Costly is to understand and live by as if Christ is all and we are nothing. Costly grace is where we become Christ Himself. Let us remember that it can never be acquired unless it is practiced. We should prepare ourselves to perfect the costly discipleship within us.

Discipleship is therefore practicing this grace in day-to-day life. Grace is not what Jesus gives us. Grace is what we give Him in return. Grace is what how well we imitate Jesus. Grace is to expect death in everything we do. Grace is what drives us towards the purity of discipleship. Grace is the most beautiful relationship that Christ Jesus expects from us.




