Let us pray that migrants fleeing from war or hunger, forced to undertake journeys fraught with danger and violence, may find welcome and new living opportunities in their host countries.



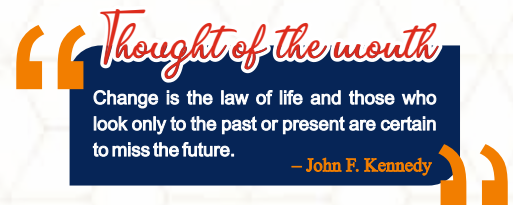

Magnifica Humanitas: A Call to Remain Truly Human

In Magnifica Humanitas, (encyclical) Pope Leo XIV addresses one of the most pressing realities of our time: the rapid growth of artificial intelligence and digital technology. While recognizing the immense benefits of technological progress, he asks a deeper question: Will technology serve humanity, or will humanity become subject to technology?

The Pope reminds us that we stand at a crucial crossroads. Using the biblical images of the Tower of Babel and the rebuilding of Jerusalem, he presents two possible futures. One is a world driven by pride, power, profit, and technological domination, where human dignity is sacrificed for efficiency and control. The other is a world built on communion, solidarity, justice, and faith in God, where technology serves the common good and promotes authentic human flourishing.

At the heart of the encyclical is the conviction that every human person possesses an inviolable dignity because each one is created in the image and likeness of God. Human worth cannot be measured by intelligence, productivity, wealth, social status, or technological capability. No machine can replace the human heart, conscience, freedom, creativity, or the capacity to love. Technology is a gift, but it must always remain a servant and never become a master.

Drawing from the rich tradition of Catholic Social Teaching, Pope Leo XIV reaffirms the principles of the common good, solidarity, subsidiarity, social justice, and the universal destination of goods. He calls for a responsible and ethical use of technology that protects the poor, workers, migrants, the elderly, and all those who risk being excluded from the benefits of progress. True development is measured not by technological advancement alone but by the extent to which human dignity, truth, freedom, fraternity, and peace are safeguarded.

For us as Brothers of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, this encyclical has a special significance. In a world increasingly captivated by machines and algorithms, we are called to witness to the irreplaceable value of the human person and the transforming love of the Heart of Christ. Through our ministries of education, formation, and pastoral care, we are entrusted with forming hearts as well as minds. No technology can replace compassionate presence, personal accompaniment, fraternal relationships, or the healing power of genuine Christian love.

Ultimately, Magnifica Humanitas is a message of hope. Pope Leo XIV does not call us to fear the future but to shape it with wisdom, faith, and responsibility. His appeal is simple yet profound: "Remain profoundly human." By keeping God at the center of our lives and placing the human person at the heart of every decision, we can help build a civilization of love where technology serves humanity and where humanity reflects ever more clearly the image of God.

May this encyclical inspire us to become builders of communion, defenders of human dignity, and witnesses to the compassionate love of the Sacred Heart of Jesus in a rapidly changing world.
